<b>Grade K</b>	
<b>Measurement and Data (K.MD)</b>	
Describe measurable attributes of objects, such as length or weight. Describe several measurable attributes of a single object. (K.MD.1)	1, 17–18
Directly compare two objects with a measurable attribute in common, to see which object has “more of/less of” the attribute, and describe the difference. (K.MD.2)	2–18
Classify objects into given categories; count the number of objects in each category and sort the categories by count. (K.MD.3)	19–20
<b>Grade 1</b>	
<b>Measurement and Data (1.MD)</b>	
Order three objects by length; compare the lengths of two objects indirectly by using a third object. (1.MD.1)	1–10
Express the length of an object as a whole number of length units, by laying multiple copies of a shorter object (the length unit) end to end . . . with no gaps or overlaps. (1.MD.2)	1–10
Tell and write time in hours and half-hours using analog and digital clocks. (1.MD.3)	11–14
Organize, represent, and interpret data with up to three categories; ask and answer questions about the total number of data points, how many in each category, and how many more or less are in one category than in another. (1.MD.4)	15–20
