The incredible word building game

Basic words are made up of onsets (beginnings) and rimes (endings). These patterns are common to many words which contain the same letters and make the same sound. (ball, call, fall, hall, wall, etc.)

Chunks includes the most commonly found onsets and rimes and provides a fun way to discover and remember these patterns.

Rules of Play

- Place all tiles face down on the table.
- The first player picks up two tiles (one of each colour), and if these tiles can be made into a word, the word is placed face up on the table in front of that player. If not the tiles are returned face down onto the table.
- Play continues with the next player picking up two tiles, and so
- A player can swap the tiles picked up by exchanging them with tiles already made into words in front of that player, provided that new words are then made with the exchanged tiles. Tiles cannot be swapped with those tiles made into words by other players.
- When all the face down tiles are gone the game is over and the winner is the player who has made the most words.
